

**UTILIZATION OF EVIDENCE PRESENTED
IN
UNDERGRADUATE PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAM ANALYSIS**

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The faculty of the CUH undergraduate Psychology department was sent the 8/4/06 *Undergraduate Psychology Program Analysis* document in August of 2006 for review. The document was initially discussed at the first departmental meeting, 8/16/06, of the Fall 2006 term. The final discussion occurred during first departmental meeting, 1/26/07, of the Spring 2007 term.

The general conclusion was that the evidence, from multiple sources, clearly supported the effectiveness of the undergraduate Psychology program relative to program student learning outcomes being met. It was agreed, however, that: 1) a rubric needed to be developed for the capstone course itself (PSY 490); 2) a rubric needed to be developed for the two required papers in the capstone course; and 3) a 50 item multiple-choice exam be developed to provide further evidence relative to program student learning outcomes being met. The two rubrics and the multiple-choice exam will be developed and implemented during the Spring 2007 term.
