

## **English**

Each student will submit a portfolio that contains the following:

1. An introduction letter (this letter will introduce the contents of the portfolio and detail how the contents meet the program learning outcomes. It should also include vocational goals and a reflection/projection of their continued learning process);
2. An analytical literary research paper with revisions (outcome 1);
3. An original work of poetry, fiction, or non-fiction (outcome 2);
4. An essay that demonstrates student knowledge of one or several period(s) in British Literature. The student must cite specific authors and texts in his/her response. (outcome 4 and 5);
5. An essay that demonstrates student knowledge of one or several period(s) in American Literature. The student must cite specific authors and texts in his/her response. (outcome 4 and 5).

The portfolio will be evaluated as part of the graduation clearance process by the student's advisor, reporting to the discipline the relative levels of achievement data in support of the program outcomes as well data gathered from courses taken for the minor from the discipline.
