Successful completion of major requirements guarantees that, at a minimum, students will have mastered the skills and competencies detailed in the Humanities major. Further Program Learning Outcomes are linked to the courses in the specific program of study developed by the faculty advisor and student. At the time of the development of a course of study, the faculty advisor will submit an assessment plan which integrates the shared program outcomes with the outcomes found in the area concentration within the degree. Students will be responsible for maintenance of a portfolio of individual work examples, which is linked to the program outcomes as presented in the course of study that is consistent with their approved assessment plan. The Senior Thesis is the primary assessment tool and intellectual product of the program. It is developed and completed in HU 494 Senior Thesis Research (3) and HU 498 Senior Thesis Writing (3) (or equivalent courses from the area of concentration.)
